Attendance Policy

Payment is for reserving a lesson time with the teacher each week. Students are expected to be at their lesson each week at the time allocated. Failure to do so will mean that the lesson is forfeited.

Cancellation Policy

We require 24 hours notice of cancellation, regardless of circumstances.

There are no refunds or credits given for lessons not attended.

Lessons cancelled by the teacher will be rescheduled ASAP.

In the event that a teacher cannot reschedule, one of our other teachers will be assigned to complete the lesson(s) remaining.

Make Up Lesson Policy

When 24 hours notice is given, a make up lesson will be arranged.

Make up lessons are subject to the teachers schedule and must be completed within the current Term.

A maximum of 2 make up lessons per Term will be given.

Any make up lessons remaining at the end of the Term will be forfeited.

Payment Policy

Lesson fees are payable one term in advance.

Fees are due one week prior to the beginning of Term in order to reserve a time.

Term payments received in advance are charged at the rate of \$30 per lesson.

All other payments (monthly and part-term) are charged at the rate of \$33.

Lessons will not be given until payment is received.

If you have difficulty paying for all of your lessons in advance you can ask for a temporary payment plan. This enables you to pay weekly at the rate of \$36 per lesson. Note that weekly payment is a temporary arrangement and not an ongoing payment option.

We accept cash, eftpos or direct deposit for lesson payments.

Credit card payments incur a 2% surcharge.
